Applications are invited from qualified candidates for 26 vacant posts of Additional District & Sessions Judge/Izafi Zilla Qazi (BPS-20) from the citizens of Pakistan, who hold the domicile of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The applications on the prescribed form must reach this Office on or before 20TH January,2023. Late applications will not be entertained.

PART-I <u>QUALIFICATION/EXPERIENCE: -</u>

- i. Advocate having LLB or equivalent degree from a recognized university entitling him/her to practice the profession of law or is a barrister of England or Ireland, or is a Member of the Faculty of Advocates of Scotland; and
- ii. Who is a practicing Advocate of the <u>High Court and/or the Courts</u>

 <u>subordinate thereto</u> with a minimum practice of eight years. (Eightyear practice as an Advocate shall be counted from the date when an
 Advocate becomes a registered member of any Bar Association of the
 Province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa till the last date fixed for submission
 of applications).
- iii. The experience of practicing as an Advocate shall also include service rendered as Govt: Pleader, Additional Government Pleader, Public Prosecutor or Additional Public Prosecutor.

Part Il AGE:-

The candidate must not be less than 35 years or more than 45 years of age, as on the last date fixed for submission of applications.

GUIDELINES

- The Screening test, except for English proficiency, shall be an objective type comprising multiple-choice questions.
- 2. There shall be no negative marking for the wrong answers.
- Marks obtained in the screening test will not count for determining the final order of merit.

 - i. At least 40% marks in English Proficiency; and
 - ii. 40 marks of the 100 as a whole in the screening test.
- 5. Screening test will be conducted at the principal seat as well as at all benches.
- 6. Time allowed for the screening test will be 100 minutes.

- 1. For Civil Law-1 & Criminal Law-1, the allocation of marks shall be as follows:
 - i. The candidate shall be required to attempt ten out of fifteen questions
 - ii. Each question shall carry ten marks.
- 2. The interview will be of 100 marks
- 3. A candidate must secure:
- At least 40 percent marks in each paper and 50 percent marks in aggregate to qualify for the interview; and
- ii. At least 50 percent marks in the interview to qualify for the final merit list.
- 4. The marks obtained in the interview will be added to the marks obtained in the written papers, and the candidate's place in merit will depend on the aggregate of both.

- 2. Candidates are advised to fill all columns carefully.
- 3. Candidates should attach the following documents to the application:
 - All Education Certificates such as Matric/Inter/B.A/LLB and any additional qualification such as MA, LLM etc.
 - National Identity Card (CNIC).
 - Eight-year experience certificate as an advocate by the concerned President District
 Bar Association, stating the date when the Advocate acquired the member of a Bar



Association and duly countersigned by the concerned District & Sessions Judge or the Additional District & Sessions Judge.

- Enrolment Certificate as an advocate of Lower Courts duly verified by the Secretary KP Bar council.
- Enrolment Certificate as an advocate of High Court duly verified by the President of respective Bars.
- Character Certificate from the President of the concerned District Bar Association.
- Latest passport size attested photograph.
- The fee challan form for the Screening Test
- Govt. Pleader, Additional Govt. Pleader, Public Prosecutor or Additional Public Prosecutor
 will apply through proper channel along with NOC and Experience Certificate from their
 Competent Authority.

PART-VI SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- The qualified candidates will remain on probation in terms of Section 9 of Khyber a) Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Service Rules 2001.
- No candidate shall be called for an interview unless he/she obtains 40% marks in b) each written paper and 50% marks in aggregate. No candidate shall be considered to have qualified for an appointment unless he /she also passes the interview. Failure or absence in an interview shall mean that the candidate (s) has failed to qualify for an appointment and his/her name will not be included in the merit list.
- c) The High Court reserves the right to Increase or Decrease the number of posts or not to fill any post or to frame any kind of policy in the light of prevalent rules and regulations.
- d) Mere submission of application form, appearance in Written Examination and Interview would not confer the right of appointment on anyone.
- e) Any adverse material against any Advocate or concealment of facts by any Advocate, false information or misstatement made in any document shall render the candidate disqualified.
- f) The list of provisionally accepted/rejected applicants will be uploaded on the website of Peshawar High Court, Peshawar i.e www.peshawarhighcourt.gov.pk as per the calendar.
- g) The applicants whose applications are rejected may apply for a review within two working days after uploading of the list.
- h) After the decision on review petitions, the final list of applicants eligible for screening test/examination will be uploaded on the Peshawar High Court Peshawar official website.
- No TA/DA will be admissible for the candidates appearing in the Test/Interview.
- j) An applicant who earlier resigned due to proceedings under the Efficiency & Discipline Rules or has been dismissed from service shall not be eligible to apply.
- k) Rechecking, re-evaluation shall not be allowed.
